## Resolution in Support of Dillon's Law (HR3910)

- Whereas: Dillon's Law honors the life of Dillon Mueller who passed away at the age of 18 due to
- anaphylaxis complications as result of a bee sting;
- Whereas: Dillon's Law saves lives by promoting opportunities for people to be trained to administer life-
- 5 saving epinephrine to those experiencing anaphylactic shock;
- 6 Whereas: Dillon's Law pushes epinephrine training to be more widely available, which prevents future
- 7 tragedies due to anaphylaxis from occurring;
- 8 Whereas: Dillon's Law provides states with the preference to allow trained individuals to carry and
- 9 administer epinephrine;
- 10 Whereas: Dillon's Law incentivizes states through grant prioritization to train, certify and enable
- individuals to safely administer epinephrine in necessary situations prior to the arrival of emergency
- 12 medical personnel;1
