Resolution in Support of Guaranteed Admissions

- Whereas, Governor Tony Evers signed Senate Bill 367, now 2023 Wisconsin Act 95; 2
- Whereas, This act requires the Board of Regents to create a guaranteed admissions program for select 3
- 4 high school graduates in Wisconsin;
- Whereas, This act accounts for and establishes guaranteed admissions standards and definitions for 5
- differing class sizes as well as home-based and virtual high school students. 6
- Whereas, Students who rank within the top 5% of their class will be admitted into UW-Madison and the 7
- top 10% will be admitted to all the Universities of Wisconsin; 8
- Whereas; This act allows for exceptions regarding student misconduct or significant grade decline that 9
- 10 warrants revocation before admission application;
- Whereas, This will effectively streamline the admission process for perspective high school graduates 11
- who may not know where to attend college; 12
- Whereas, Having a guaranteed admission program will also aid in enrollment efforts at the Universities 13
